<u>Tues 27 February:</u> We have too often listened to the clamour of the world and listened too little to your still, small voice. Forgive us and help us.

<u>Weds 28 February:</u> We pray for the work of FIND and all the Top Up shops in our town. Bless and strengthen all who give their time to collect, to sort, to deliver or to help in many different ways.
