Friday 27 November: Fill us with patience and prayer to set aside time to study our bible.

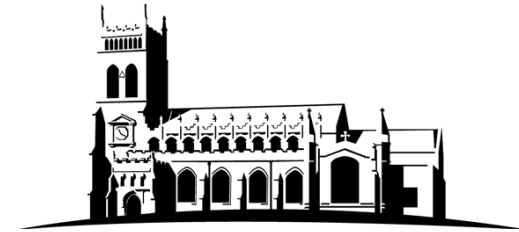
Saturday 28 November: We pray for the Bishops' teaching morning on zoom, looking at Mark's Gospel this Advent.
