Friday 9 March: We pray for our local government, for our Councillors, and council employees.

Saturday 10 March: We pray for our uniformed groups and especially for all the leaders who give their time so freely.

Sunday 11 March: Mothering Sunday. We pray for parents, and those who care for children.

Monday 12 March: We pray for the work of Christian Aid as Bishop Mike chairs a local meeting today.

Tuesday 13 March: We pray for our home groups and the Discussion Group as members share fellowship and learn from each other.

Wednesday 14 March: We pray for all who work in the NHS in our town. We acknowledge their dedication and service, and are grateful for their contributions to the well-being of others

Thursday 15 March: We thank you for our families and friends, both here in Ipswich and in many distant places, and ask for your blessing on them all.

Friday 16 March: There are many refugees and asylum-seekers in our town: may we welcome them and offer support and

friendship, remembering that Jesus and his family had to take refuge in a strange land.

Saturday 17 March: St Patrick's Day. We pray for unity amongst Christians and better understanding between those who follow Jesus.

Sunday 18 March: We pray for all who help in our church – our churchwardens, our PCC members, our elders, those who help at services, with our wonderful building and with our Church Centre.

Monday 19 March: We pray for our Men's Group and for the fellowship they offer.

Tuesday 20 March: As we welcome the Spring, we pray for those who have lost hope, that they will be given support in their struggle.

Wednesday 21 March: We pray for our vicar David, for John and Keith our Associate Ministers, and for Sarah, our Reader in training.

Thursday 22 March: each evening in Ipswich volunteers for the Soup Kitchen provide food and drink to those in need. We pray for those who give, and for those who receive.

Friday 23 March: UN World Meteorological Day. Make us good stewards of creation. Help us to be more aware of our use of the world's natural resources.

Saturday 24 March: We pray for peace and justice throughout the world, and especially for countries suffering war and civil unrest.
