Wednesday 29th April:

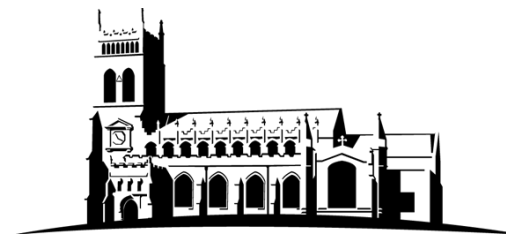
Lord, we remember all those millions of people living in war-torn countries, displaced during conflict, enduring appalling hardships and unable to plan for the future.
