Sunday 27th April: Lord, we pray for our families and loved ones to be protected. May you be their shield and may you keep them secure and safe from harm.


Monday 28th April: Dear Lord, creator of all living things. We thank you for the wonderful animals in our world. Please keep them safe, healthy and free from harm.
